## Reason 1: Employees will be more productive\*.



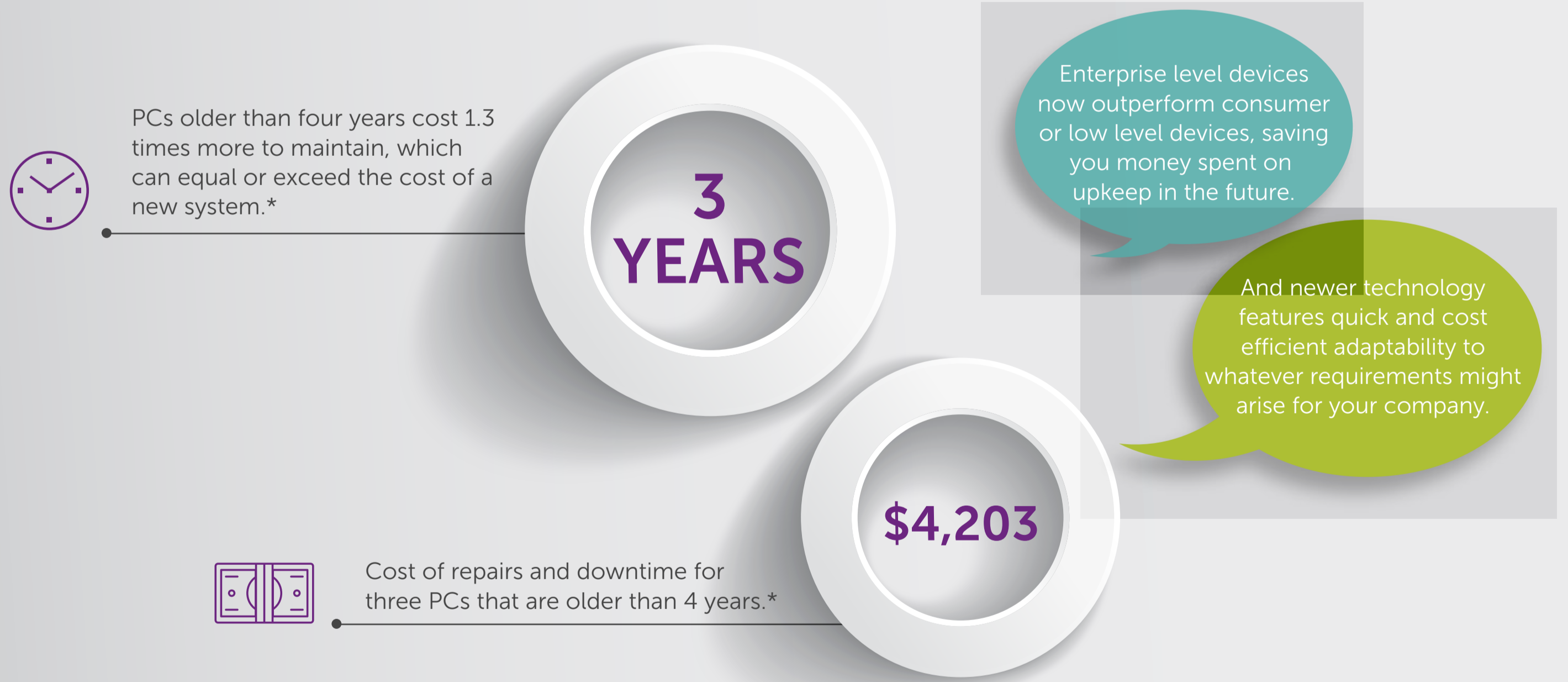
